

Why do I need an IHI?

To have your vaccinations for clinical placement uploaded to the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR), you will need an IHI (Individual Healthcare Identifier) number. (Your IHI number will be 16 digits long)

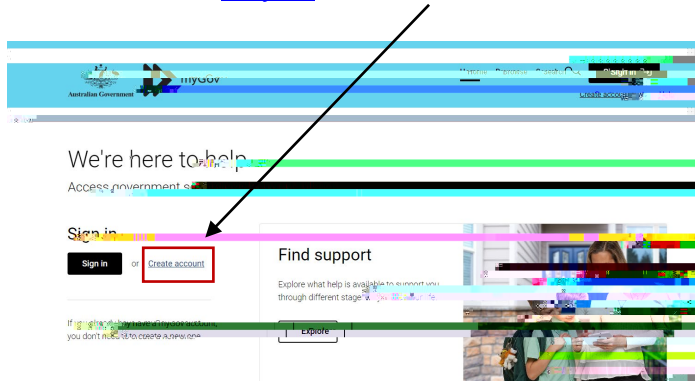
The quickest way to get an IHI is online through your [myGov account](https://my.gov.au) (<https://my.gov.au>). If you don't have an account, it's easy to [create one](https://my.gov.au/en/about/help/mygovwebsite/createmygovaccount) (<https://my.gov.au/en/about/help/mygovwebsite/createmygovaccount>) on the myGov website.

You'll need one of the following identification documents to upload to the website

- x your passport, with a valid Australian Visa
- x your Australian driver licence.

These documents will be used to identify you. Follow these steps to get an IHI online:

1. Create a [myGov](https://my.gov.au) account.



2. Sign in to myGov

3. Select services or link [(F)14 w 7ua service.

Select IHI service from the list



Follow the prompts to get your IHI, and then select link the service.
